

# Pilot/Escort Vehicle Operator



The training standards for P/EVO certification and the Evergreen Safety Council program comply with guidelines established by the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP). The training focuses on state regulations, procedures, safety practices, and operator responsibilities.

## To Receive Certification:

- Complete a one-day (approximately eight hours) training course.
- Complete an open-book examination and achieve a minimum score of 80%.

A successful candidate will receive a WSDOT P/EVO certification card that is valid for three years. The certification card may have a passport-size picture attached and can be laminated. Otherwise, a driver's license must be shown if asked for verification of identification.

## Requirements for Performing as a P/EVO

- You must be 18 years old and have a valid driver's license from any of the 50 U.S. states or from any Canadian Provinces or Territories.
- You must be able to read and speak English.
- You must be able to perform flagging duties and traffic control.
- You must be drug and alcohol free when performing P/E vehicle duties.
- You must carry minimum liability insurance as required by Washington State.

- You must wear corrective lenses while performing P/E duties if they required for driving.

This course also includes information relating to the Pilot/Escort requirements for western Canada.

## Each candidate will receive:

- Washington State P/EVO manual
- Washington State P/EVO window decal
- Washington State Operator Certification Card
- Pilot Car Escort Best Practices Guidelines manual
- Canadian General Oversize Regulations and Pilot Car Directory
- Certified Pilot/Escort Vehicle Operator handout.

This is a one day course that can be held at locations of your choice.
